## <u>New Life Korean School Newsletter</u>

#### Dear Parents,

It is amazing to realize that it's already September and it has been almost a month since our school started. All teachers and staff want to thank you for your continuing support.

### 1. Requests

- All students at New Life Korean School (NLKS) work really hard to learn and practice Korean. However, we are seeing some students arriving at classrooms after the school starts. We know that it is challenging for you to pick up students after their daytime schools and drop them off again at NLKS. However, the class will be less disruptive if all students wait for their teachers five minutes before the class starts (5:25 PM).
- We are also witnessing that some students are very hungry (not necessarily hangry) during the first session of the school. It will be beneficial for your students if they have a small snack before they come to NLKS. Please also have them bring their water bottles.
- If your children cannot make it to school, please email us or text their teachers so they can prepare for their class in advance.
- Your children will have homework assignments in most weeks, so please help them finish them before coming to school.

#### 2. Special Acuities on Chuseok (Korean Thanksgiving Day)

- September 10th is Chuseok, one of the biggest traditional holidays in Korea. To celebrate this holiday with our students, our teachers will help your children make traditional lanterns (Chungsa Chorong) this Friday (9/9).
- In the first session, students will make these lanterns and then play Korean traditional games in the second session.
- To make the lantern, students need an empty paper carton as is shown below. You can recycle one milk/orange juice carton by cutting the top part, rinsing inside with water, and drying it. Have your kids bring it to school on this Friday so every student can participate in this fun activity.
- If your children have traditional Korean consumes (Hanbok), we want to see them wear it when they come to school.

- Korean History/Culture Experience Event
  - o There will be no class on the first Friday of October (10/7). Instead, all students will attend Korean History/Culture Experience Event on October 8<sup>th</sup> at 10 AM.
  - o It will be held at Denver Disciple Mission Church of Denver (8390 E. Hampden Ave., 80231).
  - On this Friday (9/9), teachers will ask if your children will be coming to the event.
- Fall Break
  - As announced before, the fall break will be October 21st.
