As we embark on the spring semester of 2024, we are pleased to send you the first newsletter with important information. Please take a moment to review the contents.

1. School Operations

- Spring Semester Duration: January 26th – May 10th
- Class Hours: 5:30 PM – 7:30 PM
- Students can arrive from 5:00 PM, and classes will begin promptly at 5:30 PM. To facilitate smooth class progression, we kindly request students to be seated in classrooms by 5:30 PM.
- Regular classes conclude at 7:30 PM, followed by the AWANA program at 7:40 PM. Students participating in AWANA can be picked up at the church at 9:00 PM.

2. Opening Day Schedule

- Date & Time: January 26th, 5:30 PM, NRG Room

- On the opening day, all students and parents will gather to meet teachers. Students will then proceed to their respective classrooms with their teachers.
- Please be aware that students may be assigned to different classrooms starting from the second week based on their level test results.
- If this is your first time enrolling your child in our school, we recommend joining a brief parent orientation right after the opening ceremony.

3. Registration Fee Payment

- Registration fees can be paid in cash or by check (payable to New Life Korean School, with student's name in the memo).
- Payment can be made at the check-in table on the opening day.
- First student: \$200, Second: \$180, Third: \$150, Fourth: \$120

4. Student and Parent Notes

- Please provide information about students' food preferences or allergies to the principal, vice principal, or class teacher during this week's attendance.
- Class teachers may request specific materials. Additionally, preparing a bag and water bottle with the student's name will aid in the commuting process.
- To ensure a safe learning environment for all members of our school, please cooperate by strictly adhering to our school regulations.
- After the level test on the first day, students can be assigned to a different class starting from the second week. In the event of such a change, you will be notified, so please don't be confused by this potential adjustment.

5. Spring Semester Special Events

- Spring Break: March 29th (Easter break). Classes will continue during Cherry Creek School District spring break week.
- Colorado Korean School Association Writing/Drawing Contest: Scheduled for April 27th (optional program and details to be announced).
- Korean School Marketplace: May 10th (In-house event immediately following the end of semester ceremony).

6. Parents Meal Service Volunteers

- Our school provides dinner for students, and parental volunteers are needed. We kindly ask parents to volunteer at least twice during the semester.
- Volunteers will assist the meal service team. On the assigned day, please arrive at the school around 5:00 PM to meet the kitchen volunteers.
