Our New Life Korean School began its spring semester on January 26th, 2024, thanks to the interest and support of parents and students. We appreciate your efforts in bringing students to school on time, preparing their homework and materials, and helping them learn Korean language and culture. School Operation

- Spring Semester Dates: January 26th May 10th
- Class Hours: 5:30 PM 7:30 PM

Students may arrive at school from 5:00 PM, and classes will begin promptly at 5:30 PM. Please cooperate to ensure that teachers can start their classes at 5:30 PM for smooth class progress.

Regular classes end at 7:30 PM, and the New Life Mission Church's AWANA program starts at 7:40 PM. Students participating in AWANA can be picked up at the church at 9:00 PM.

Please take note that, starting from February (from March 1st), our school will no longer accept additional registrations for stable class operation.

Registration Fee Payment

If you have not yet paid the registration fee, you can pay in cash or by check (payable to New Life Korean School, with the student's name written on the memo). Please deliver it to a school staff member or volunteer accountant.

Health and Safety Precautions

If you have not informed us about foods that students should be cautious about eating or allergies, please notify the principal/vice-principal or class teacher immediately.

It appears that colds and COVID are actively circulating in our area. If you think there is a risk of your child infecting other students due to a high fever or cough, please do not send them to school and cooperate so they can recover at home. If a student's cold or other symptoms are deemed to be a concern for the health of other school members, we may contact parents for early pickup. We ask for your understanding.

To create a safe learning environment for all members of our school, please cooperate in adhering to <u>our school's policy</u>.

Parent Meal Service Volunteers

Our school provides dinner for students and requires parent volunteers. We hope that each parent can volunteer at least twice during the semester. When contacted for volunteer opportunities, please actively assist.

Our school's meal service team prepares meals for students, so parent volunteers will be assigned simple tasks to assist the meal service team in the kitchen on their assigned days. Please come to the school (around 5:00 PM) on your assigned day to meet with the kitchen volunteers.

- March 8th & 15th: Lower grades learn traditional musical instrument (Sogo), upper grades learn calligraphy (Seoye)
- March 29th: Spring break (Easter)
