Please carefully review the information below regarding our upcoming opening ceremony on Friday. Additionally, we kindly request that you familiarize yourself with the following information to ensure a healthy and safe learning environment for all students throughout the semester.

1. School Operations

- Fall Semester Dates: August 16 - November 22
- Class Times: 5:30 PM - 7:25 PM
- Students may be dropped off starting at 5:00 PM, but classes will begin promptly at 5:30 PM. To ensure a smooth start to class, please have your children seated in their classrooms by 5:30 PM. Please note that regular classes will end at 7:25 PM starting this semester, unlike the previous semesters. (We will provide additional information about AWANA as it becomes available.)

2. Opening Day Schedule

- Date & Time: Friday, August 16 at 5:30 PM in the NRG Service Room
- On opening day, all students and parents will gather to meet the teachers. Students will then follow their teachers to their respective classrooms.
- *Please note that students may be assigned to different classrooms starting the second week based on their assessment results.*

3. Registration Fee Payment

- Tuition can be paid in cash or by check (payable to New Life Korean School, please write the student's name in the memo) at the check-in table on opening day.
- First child: \$200, Second child: \$180, Third child: \$150, Fourth child: \$120

4. Student and Parent Notes

- Please provide information about students' food preferences or allergies to the principal, vice principal, or class teacher during this week's attendance.
- Class teachers may request specific materials. Additionally, preparing a bag and water bottle with the student's name will aid in the commuting process.
- To ensure a safe learning environment for all members of our school, please cooperate by strictly adhering to [our school regulations](#).
- New Life Korean School is supported by New Life Mission Church. Students may learn about the Bible, sing hymns, and pray as needed.

5. Parents Meal Service Volunteers

- Our school provides dinner for students, and we need parent volunteers. We ask that you volunteer at least twice a semester.
- The school's meal preparation team will prepare the meals, and parent volunteers will assist with simple tasks. Please meet the school volunteers in the kitchen at around 5:00 PM on your assigned day.
